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**Statement of Purpose for the CritiCall Ontario
Provincial Hospital Resource System Repatriation Tool Data Holding**

As a “Health Information Network Provider,” CritiCall Ontario makes the Repatriation Tool, a component of the Provincial Hospital Resource System (PHRS), available to all acute care hospitals in Ontario. The Repatriation Tool provides a method to electronically document repatriation activity related to the movement of patients between acute care hospitals. Hospitals enter data into the Repatriation Tool and share this information electronically with other hospitals that in turn, can indicate their ability to accept or not accept a particular patient in accordance with the specified date. All hospitals are responsible for and have access to their data within the system.

CritiCall Ontario generates statistical reports from the Repatriation Tool to provide hospitals, Local Health Integration Networks and the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care with information about repatriation activity and challenges. This data can be used by those stakeholders to identify and implement strategies to deal with any ongoing issues that may be impeding the timely repatriation of acute care patients.
